Games. We will need every Arrowman to help in all of these events for us to be successful. I know that we can count on you to actively support these functions.



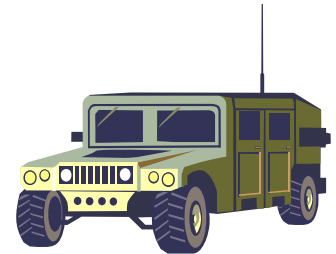
